## Concerns and Recommendations: Dr Julian Prior

- High value biodiversity conservation area, in terms of terrestrial & aquatic species & communities, & as a climate-change refuge zone
- Inadequate and manipulative community consultation, with no opportunity to interrogate the technical consultants
- No adequate *aquatic ecology impact assessment (Bell's Turtle?)*
- Inadequate assessment of impacts on *catchment processes, soil erosion, and turbidity,* and aquatic ecology resulting from tree clearing, road construction, and turbine foundation pads, on undulating to steep land and on highly erodible soils

## **Recommendations: require that the proponent**

- 1. Undertake an appropriate community-level consultation where their technical consultants can be interrogated by the community regarding their impact assessments and mitigation measures
- 2. Undertake a scientifically rigorous aquatic ecology impact assessment
- 3. Undertake a proper analysis of development impacts on catchment processes, soil erosion, and turbidity


