

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Bulga Optimisation Project (Open Cut Extension) Singleton Local Government Area

The former Minister for Planning, pursuant to Section 23D of the NSW *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979, has directed the Planning Assessment Commission to review the proposed Bulga Optimisation Project, and hold a public hearing during the review.

The terms of reference for the Commission are:

- a) consider the Department of Planning and Environment's (DP&E) assessment report of the merits of the project;
- b) consider the EIS for the project, the issues raised in submissions, the formal response to submissions, the amended project application report and any other relevant information provided on the project during the course of the review:
- c) assess the merits of the project as a whole, paying particular attention to air quality, noise and blasting impacts of the project; and
- d) recommend any further measures required to avoid, minimise, and/or manage the potential impacts of the project.
