Request to the Planning Assessment Commission: Russell Vale Colliery Underground Expansion Project

Section 23D of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979
Clauses 268R and 268V of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000

- I, the Minister for Planning, request the Planning Assessment Commission to:
- 1. Carry out a review of the Russell Vale Colliery Underground Expansion Project, and:
 - consider the EA for the project, the issues raised in submissions, the formal response to submissions, the Preferred Project Report, the Residual Matters Report, the Department of Planning & Environment's preliminary assessment report of the project, and any other relevant information provided on the project to the Commission during the course of the review;
 - b) assess the merits of the project as a whole, paying particular attention to the potential impacts to:
 - upland swamps and water resources (especially Cataract Creek and the stored waters of Cataract Reservoir) resulting from mine subsidence; and
 - residents in the vicinity of the Russell Vale pit top resulting from noise and air emissions and the trucking of product coal;
 - c) apply all relevant NSW Government policies in that consideration and assessment; and
 - provide recommendations on any reasonable and feasible measures that could be implemented to avoid, reduce and/or offset the potential impacts of the project.
- 2. Conduct public hearings on the project no later than 30 January 2015.
- 3. Complete the review by 20 March 2015, unless the Secretary of the Department of Planning and Environment agrees otherwise.
