Now that is being threatened by placing a toxic industrial building in the middle of an urban area. The company report we can be safe if we just limit the time we spend outside. That is ridiculous in a rural area. What about the animals? Are we putting them inside too? This is particularly relevant due to the nearby Garvan institute. The roads do not support the trucks they will need to, and are in poor condition as they are without the truck movements. A similar factory recently caught fire in Kurri Kurri NSW. The Moss Vale facility will be in close vicinity to housing and the town centre. I am concerned about the health outcomes for the local humans and animals due to microplastics, and also for the drinking water that provides for a large area. Children should be able to play in parks and go for walks, not sit inside because the air is toxic. Overall, this is not the site for a large, toxic factory.
