Hello, as a resident with primary school age children who were directly approached by plasrefine to be 'educated' as to the benefits of this proposal, which I find reprehensible in itself, I have concerns for the position upstream from warragamba dam potentially causing devastating pollution to the drinking water and land use purposes of surrounding agricultural land. I also have an extreme objection as a health and safety officer for a mine site in my previous career. Due diligence has surely not been ascertained for a site which is not easily accessible for fire and rescue and emergency response with state emergency services probably 30 minutes away or more in event of a fire which is highly likely with even one sorting error and a battery spark sparking a fire the whole area will be engulfed in toxic fumes. This happened in the ACT as recently as 2022 and we have 45,000 residents in the area with children and families not the right place for such extreme hazardous material and long term effects which are as yet unproven.
