I object to the Hills of Gold wind farm proposal.

Visual

Lot 22, being adjacent to this proposal will be highly impacted visually. Most of the day we are out and about not locked up in houses. WE will be exposed to shadow flicker – exceeding the allowable annual amount, blade glint, blade throw and ice throw during winter periods. Our visual landscape will be ruined.

Transport.

Getting to and from our property will be greatly hindered during construction and once constructed we will have to navigate around the turbines. No definitive transport route has been put forward, so we also have the uncertain factor of how many more ways we will be adversely affected.

Biodiversity

The proposal discusses how they intend to displace our native fauna. Wild animals do not acclimate ready in new areas that can be already occupied by other animals, they have a tendency to return to their original areas.

Environment

I believe that this project will have an adverse effect on our environment.

NB we have a DA approval for a dwelling that has already been started, inspected and certified on our lot. This seems to have been ignored.

I also want to bring attention to the Independent Planning commissioners that we have not signed any agreements with the proponent. No neighbourhood agreement and no biodiversity stewardship has been signed.
