Dear George,

Further to our telephone conversation on Wednesday 31 January 2018 I am writing to confirm the Commission considered the requests in your letter dated 24 January 2018. On this occasion the Commission decided it would not direct Government agencies to appear at the upcoming public hearing for Wambo United Coal Project.

The Commission will be publishing your letter on our website along with a yet to be received response from the Department of Planning and Environment to the assessment issues raised. These documents will be published prior to the public hearing and the Commission will alert you as soon as those documents become available.

I can confirm the suggestions in your most recent letter and those coming from previous discussions with the Commission in September 2017 are being contemplated by the Commission as it reviews its guide to public hearings. I anticipate a new set of hearing guidelines, including transitional arrangements, will be introduced to coincide with the changes to the EP&A act and regulations scheduled to commence on 1 March 2018.
