Bango Wind Project D 502-18

- * Permanent resident, 5th generation family approaching 100% ownership of property. No income in any form is being, or will be received from this industry. Active support of solar energy.
- Turbine numbers reduction are most welcome, however acceptable outcome is that of the fighter submarine - withdrawn.
- * A second industrial turbine project would saturate our district with:
 - (a) Unstoppable bombardment of damage to fauna + flora
 - (b) Total visual pollution in every direction, esp. at the 200 m. height 75 m. blades can not be classified as "subtle" nor blending in with surroundings
 - (c) force locals to live in a world of turbines a "need in the standard" situation. Already our area has an extremely high number of residents exposed - close proximity to a large number of turbines. If no structure exists, there can be no studies to indicate no effect this may well have on health + well being. Many other health issues exist in our all previously unaffected eg. Willianstown, city suburbs clearly starved, lacking fresh gas industry, cancer clusters in London

- * Traffic roads: Again saturation as second project will use Wangella road
 - 37 light, 14 heavy vehicles you hear and sabotage our roads, rendering impossible to move stock along the road. This has not been acknowledged by DPE - of pastoral concern as it could hurt, if not lose our ability function normally in moving stock to a steady speed. The loss of income would be a most不堪able loss.
- * Upgrading of roads would result in the removal of most trees, depriving birds of shelter and totally changing the visual appearance.
- * "Outdoors" is our workplace, usual & noise impact will exist at all times - forever. Noise level reporting has been totally lacking in our opinion expression, to Dennis and flicking/moneybag interest from Wind Alliance.
- * Solar farms are producing electricity within 12 months of submitting DA's and without opposition. Installation of solar panels on West has risen 3 ton in 2018, 1 ton in 2017 despite of reduced subsidies - this increase of power is leading difficulties to storage of power.
 - How prolonged & ridiculous expense is the wind industry, always will have payments to appear individuals, communities & animals - such costs would be reduced by expensive electricity cost.

- * Total failure to consult with local aboriginal has Khar Koosall (no passed) by Heritage studies. A total insult to be knowledge documents available
- * Impossible to support this Bango project, not a necessary feature can be presented. Company dealing, implement day totally lacking in knowledge and management.
