37 light, 14 heavy vehicles per hour will sabotage our roads, rendering impossible to move stock along the road. * Solar farms are producing electricity within 12 months of submitting D'A's and without opposition.

Installation of solar panels in NSW has risen 34% in 2018, 11% in 2017 despite of reduced subsidies - this increase of power is creating dilemma to storage of power.

Now prolonged & ridiculous expense is the wind industry, always with huge payments to appease individuals, communities & locals - such costs would be reduced by excessive electricity cost.
