I would like to submit my objection to the proposed Bango Wind Farm.

My concerns about this project are:

* the village of Rye Park will be surrounded by two wind farms (Bango and Rye Park wind farms) and there is no research on the impacts a cumulative effect wind farms can have.

* I believe the wind farm will impact on the number of people who would move from a metropolitan or regional area to a rural village like Rye Park and this will therefore cause a downturn in our economy.
