There are so many unanswered questions associated with these Windfarms developments. We have concerns of noise on our property and home. Some of our concerns are:

- 1 Are these unsightly monuments a viable proposition if Government and Tax payers subsidies are cut to developers?
- 2 Do these projects affect the every day lives of non host neighbours trying to make a living from the land?
- 3 Does extra traffic affect locals going to Yass Boorowa or Canberra for work or supplies --- are the local roads capable of handling the extra traffic?
- 4 Do any of the Commissioners hearing this case live in the middle of 2 large Windfarms as the people of Rye Park will, if Bango is approved and the Trust Power project East of Rye Park which has already been approved under the name change of Tilt go ahead? I don't think there is any other town or village in Australia with 2 major Wind developments surrounding them.
- We as locals are totally fed up with these Wind Farm projects which have been around for at least 10 years .
- We have put in submissions and wasted many hours on these projects to no avail. The uncertainty that they create is holding developments of farming projects. Why develop properties if these Wind Turbines are going to be detrimental to land values.
- 7 I know there are a lot of figures around relating to what local communities will benefit from these projects. It appears that benefits from earlier projects are difficult to access. Will these funds be available to the villages that are most affected?

Hoping you will give these concerns some consideration
