The NSW Department of Planning and Environment has now completed its evaluation of this development proposal and referred it to us – the Independent Planning Commission NSW – for determination.

Because there's been so much interest in this proposal, we're holding a public meeting to listen carefully to the community's views. This is your last chance to comment on the Department's assessment report before our independent experts make a final decision on the proposal.

The meeting will be held at the Rooty Hill RSL, 55 Sherbrooke Street Rooty Hill NSW 2766, on Monday, 14 May 2018, at 11:00am.

If you wish to apply to speak at the meeting, you must register your interest by completing the attached form (also available online) and returning it via email to ipcn@ipcn.nsw.gov.au before 5:00pm on Tuesday 8 May 2018.

And if you can't make it or just don't like public speaking, that's not a problem! You can make a written submission up to one week after the meeting. Written comments are weighed the same as spoken presentations.
