I advise that Council has received a development application for the construction and use of a new cemetery and parklands at the abovementioned property in Varroville.

Due to the development's Capital Investment Value, the Sydney Western City Planning Panel is the determination authority for this application.

The proposal is identified as Nominated Integrated Development as it requires a controlled activity approval from the Office of Water under the Water Management Act 2000. The development application also seeks approval from the Rural Fire Service under the Rural Fires Act 1997.

The application has been submitted by a Crown authority for the purposes of Section 89 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.

The exhibition period concludes at the close of business on Thursday, 8 February 2018 and you have until this time to make a written submission to Council concerning the development application. Where an objection is made, the grounds of objection must be specified in the submission.

To assist you in this matter, I have enclosed a site plan master plan showing some details of the development. In addition, I have enclosed a fact sheet providing frequently asked questions, containing information detailing the public notification process and your opportunities to participate.

If you would like to comment on the application, please write to Council within the period of exhibition quoting file number 3293/2017/DA-C and include your business, mobile and any other telephone number where you can be reached during the day. You are advised that any submission made to Council regarding the proposal can be made accessible to the public under the provisions of the Government Information Public Access Act 2009.

Please be aware that under Section 147 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 a person who makes a *relevant planning application and/or a relevant public submission* to Council, is required to disclose the following *reportable political donations* and *gifts* (if any) made by any person *with a financial interest* in the application within the period commencing two years before the application is made and prior to the determination of the application.

- (a) all reportable political donations made to any local Councillor of that Council.
- (b) all gifts made to any local Councillor or employee of that Council.
