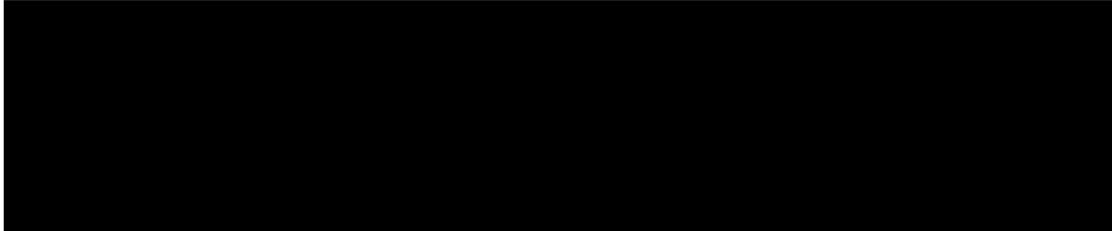
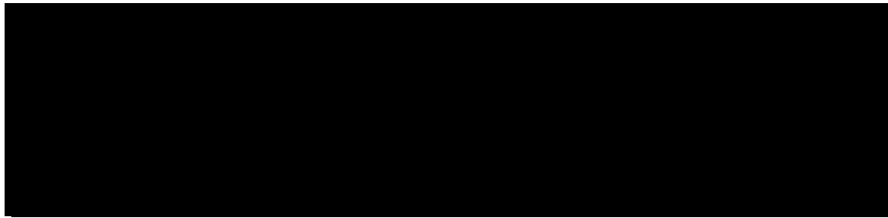

As a long time resident of Wallacia I am lodging a formal complaint regarding the proposal to destroy the village area of Wallacia by placing a crematorium and cemetery in the middle of our town. This will rob all residents of the rural atmosphere they chose to embrace by living here. This proposal will greatly increase traffic and noise on Park Rd which is now overburdened with the traffic from Warragamba and housing developments in Silverdale and already in poor repair.

It will rob local residents and members of their golf course...and also a place where elderly residents from the nearby retirement village are able to meet socially.
