

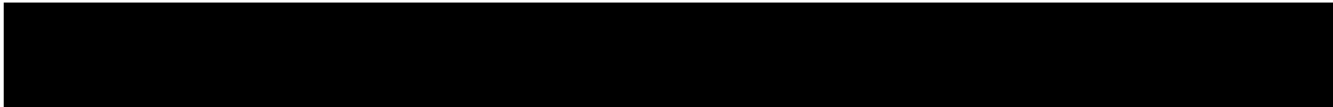

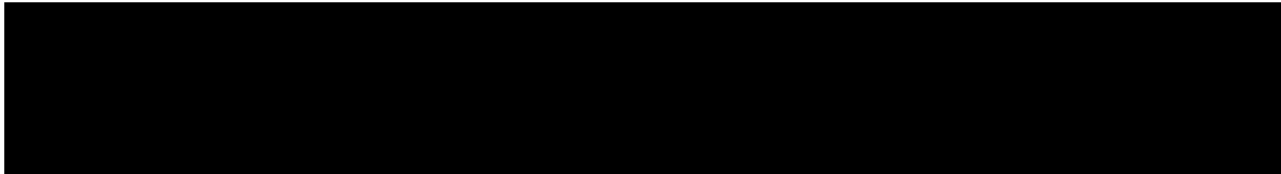
**Integrated Development Application No. DA17/1092

I would like to voice my objection to the above proposal.

We moved to this area 24 years ago with there main reason being it was semi rural and quiet. Since then we have seen many changes including trucks and semi trailers back and forth to Warragamba with the widening of the dam wall and now the airport going in at Badgerys Creek. On a daily basis we have to listen to the trucks and semi trailers constantly up and down Park Road from the quarry, banging and crashing their way along a bumpy, pot hole riddled Park Road - which was created by the trucks in the first place. We too have to drive along this road ducking and weaving pot holes. I do not now want to deal with a cemetery and all that comes with it.



For the following reasons, I object:-



I believe the value of the properties around the cemetery will be negatively affected.

I do not want to see funeral processions up and down Park Road.

I do not want to be stuck in [redacted] trying to get out on to Park Road and being caught up in or behind funeral processions and all the extra traffic this Memorial Park will bring.

I do not want the smell of the Crematorium nor the ash falling [redacted]

I do not believe new cemeteries should be placed in the middle of housing areas. There is plenty of wide open land not in residential areas that cemeteries can be built on.



Also it is noted that some of the key features of the Memorial Park is a refurbished community function centre and 42 hectares of parklands and recreation areas - come on, who in their right mind would want to spend their recreational time in the grounds and function centre of a cemetery. I think they are trying to sell the unsellable.
