



I am writing to object to the above proposal. I am not objecting to the construction of a cemetery in this area but in the heart of Wallacia Village it is absurd.

My reasons are as follows:

- leaching into Jerrys Creek and surrounds and then into the Nepean River.
- part of the development is in a 1:100 year flood zone.
- Park Rd and Mulgoa Rd and only just coping now with the traffic flow from developments in the Silverdale area (Wollondilly Council). More traffic is just going to create chaos.
- The closure of Wallacia Golf Club. This is a joke. This Club has been the heart of this village since its official opening in 1948. It was the first club in NSW to allow women to join as associate members. Despite their reassurances that the Club and the course will not close I'm sure it will and there will go another recreational area for locals and the wider community. We have already lost the Blaxland Crossing Picnic Area. When I first moved here in 1979 that area was pristine. Our kids played there on their bikes, we could walk our dogs there, we had school sports carnivals there, we had community celebrations there as well as private parties. The wider community used the area on Sundays for picnics and BBQs. Now it is a disgrace. I don't know what Penrith Council have done or more to the point not done there. But we have lost that area for recreation and do not want to lose another one.
- People live in places like Wallacia for a certain lifestyle. It is semi rural and quiet with a real sense of community. I am sure that there are many other areas in Western Sydney / North western Sydney/ South Western Sydney where the CMCT could build a cemetery without building it in the middle of a village. I am sure there is plenty of land around the new Western Sydney Airport that could be used for such a purpose.
