I cannot see how the IPC can recommend the Wallacia Golf Course would make an ideal location for a Cemetery when there has been 3 DA approved Cemetery and Crematoriums one located in Luddenham & two on Greendale Road.

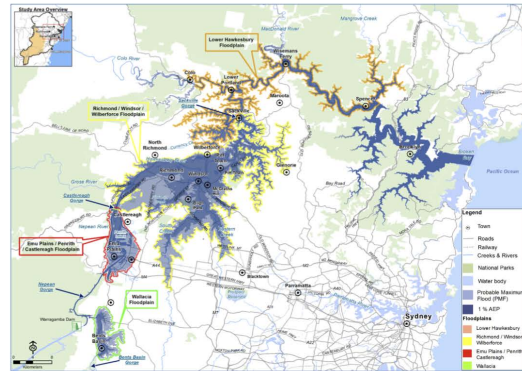
I truly believe the Golf course should be preserved as open space and parklands for the entire community to enjoy.
