I have lived in Wallacia for nearly 40 years and in a nut-shell I do not want a cemetery in my backyard.

Jerry's Creek floods after big rains and while the creek was flooded I saw people canoeing. I certainly do not want to see bodies floating beside the canoes. This would be a health risk to say the least.

Also, if a cemetery is allowed then my property will devalue as this is an undesirable amenity.

If there is a crematorium then there would be the continual smoke which, too, would be another health risk.

When this parcel of land was first sold and became a Golf Course it was stipulated that it was only ever to be used for public recreational use.

With the airport being built the towns of Luddenham, Wallacia, Mulgoa, Silverdale and Warragamba are going to grow significantly.
