



I support the West Culbura Development Proposal for the following reasons:

- * It has overwhelming community support as clearly demonstrated at the public meeting on 24th July 2018.
- *Laks Wollambook has not been adversely affected by water ranoff, tunningsted and uncontrolled since the initial Culburra development in the 1970's. Common sense dictates that with modern water controls fitting development will also have no adverse impact.
- * At the public meeting an international bird appert explained that bird life on and around the lake and ocean front was thriving (3 percent of the world's black swan population and 4 percent of the world's Teal population choose the lake as their preferred habitat) with the current nationand or non existent water controls.
- * All spokesparsons from local businesses and the chamber of commerce expressed the dire need for modest residential growth for local businesses to survive the local hardware shop is closing because of reduced trade and many shops are vacant due to the shrinkage in number of parameter residents.
- *Affordable housing, despentably needed for permanent families, is non-existent in Culburn. The very few houses that come up for sale are immediately unapped up by those looking for holiday restal investment driving prices up and excluding families from purchase. The town has a HUSING SHORTAGE.
- * The Lake Welhumbools Protection Association is in no way representative of the community and is, in fact, mistrusted by the community for good reason.

 * Many local Aboriginal people are also in dire need of housing in Culturra and I am concurred that the significant or sacred site objection is overplayed and often seems to be very subjective.
