My name is Garry Sunderland I own and live on the property FIFIELD.

We are located directly to the north less 1.5km from adjoining the proposed mine site. There are 2 homes on the property I live with my wife Narelle and in the 2nd home our daughter Nicole and her son.

I have lived on since 1968 (50Years).

The farm had been operated as a mixed farming enterprise consisting Wool, Prime Lambs and grains with my Father Bert till 2008. Since his passing in 2008 I purchased the property from the estate and we have continued with the mixed farming enterprise.

Farm improvements and more profitable production have been a major project for me. is run with our additional property 4Km to the East on the Melrose plains road.

I am involved in our small communities of Fifield Trundle and Tullamore.

I am proud of our farm and have put my whole life into it working and improving my lifelong ambition.

I fully support the requested amendments to the proposed Consent Conditions Schedule3- Environmental performance Conditions that Helen Quade submitted on behalf of Fifield Near Neighbours.

If our farm and home wasn't close I wouldn't have any concerns.

My main concerns are: I feel when the mine becomes operational the dust and noise will be of great concern to my family as my wife has health issue's with dust and chemicals.

Devaluation of rural land when a mine project is adjoining us Emissions and the fall out what effect will it have on our health the grasses etc?

The water flow that comes through the proposed mine site that fills 6 dams on Currajong Park and the other water course that flows to the east across the Fifield road runs through Warrawandi fill dams on the way. The water may only run once in every couple of years, I feel it will be greatly reduced not only for me but other farmers all the way to the Bogan River and beyond.
