

Yass Valley Wind Farm MOD 1 - IPC meeting and Site Visit

Thank you for visiting Yass on Monday to hear of this devastating situation thrust on to the non associated neighbours.

It must be noted the 'speakers' invited by Goldwind, were consumed by MONEY, especially Mr Prell, a paid employee of Wind Alliance. The last two speakers, highlighted the influence 'sponsoring' community events have on the community, they did not say if any members withdrew from the Kite Festival committee??, as has already occurred in the Bookham community.

We understand Mr Prell, from 'Wind Alliance' was invited to accompany the site visit, surely this would not be acceptable; (it is our understanding this also occurred during the Bango site visit.) We understand this visit was for the Proponents to explain the proposed (at this time) project, we anticipate another site visit with the Chair of Yass Landscape Guardians and especially the representative from Yass Earthmovers together with a non associated representative.

Regarding the Whitefield Road, a road continually considered of the 'highest ecological value' and not suitable for oversized vehicle use, to allow the Proponents such 'open ended' permission as to a 5 metre MINIMUM clearance is not acceptable, it is the MAXIMUM that must be locked into the regulations. Goldwind have a reputation with road clearance and constructing Turbines outside any 100 metre restriction limit; e.g. Gullen Range Wind Farm.

It has been noted the Turbines impacting on C06 could hardly be seen, that is correct and you would be aware Green Bean Design photography has a tendency to depict the 'wire frame' images well in the distance. Enclosed FYI the photo Epuron produced <u>after the project was approved taken from</u> C60 compared with the Goldwind photo taken in May 2017.

Also enclosed a newspaper photo of a Turbine up in flames on the Ravenshoe Wind Farm, the Turbines appear to be constructed on relative flat ground, having now visited the Coppabella's you would understand the impossibility of 'fighting' a fire on such terrain.

The map and photo enclosed was Epuron's proposed project the PAC approved on the 30th March, 2016. Without any Public Meetings.

As you would be aware every Wind Farm project is meet with constant objections, there needs to be a moratorium on any further construction until all issues are resolved.






Epuron's montage. June 2016. - after Project approved 150 M Turbeines. 2. 55 KM. Residence C60
