Objections to ongoing development in Leo Drive Narrawallee.

 Leo Drive Access. This road was a quiet development of Narrawallee – relatively well-planned, with parks, walkways and bushland, and above all healthy trees of older growth giving the area a pleasant and bushy feeling.

There seems to be no provision for walking paths, open space with trees within this new development.

The developers have arrogantly used Leo Drive as a thruway to access their moneymaking development without regard for people who have been living in this established area and negatively impacting on our surroundings and endangering our children, seniors, pets etc. to an unacceptable degree. Its only a matter of time before a begrible assident occurs.
