I wish to protest a planning decision associated with a large subdivision off Leo Drive in Narrawali NSW.

The clearing of a stand of mature Eucalyptus trees to create six more building blocks seems a little severe in a subdivision that consists of relatively large houses on relatively small blocks . A large chunk of native forest was clear felled to accommodate the new subdivision , without a single tree left as a feature of the suburb being created. This magnificent stand of trees is all that is left of a once superb habitat . The natural beauty of this area is what makes people to want to live here. Surely we must compromise the need for current and future development with that of conserving the natural beauty of this unique part of NSW.

I appeal to The Independent Planning Commission to please keep this stand of trees from being destroyed.
