



Rix's Creek South Continuation of Mining Project SSD 6300

The NSW Department of Planning and Environment has now completed its evaluation of the Rix's Creek South Continuation of Mining Project SSD 6300 and referred it to us – the Independent Planning Commission NSW – for determination.

The three-member Panel appointed by Chair of the Commission, Professor Mary O'Kane AC, to determine this state significant development application comprises Professor Mary O'Kane (Panel Chair), Mr Andrew Hutton and Mr Tony Pearson.

Because there's been so much interest in this proposal, we're holding a public meeting to listen carefully to the community's views. This is your last chance to comment on the Department's assessment report before our independent experts make a final decision.

The meeting will be held at **the Singleton Civic Centre, 12 Queen Street Singleton NSW 2330** at **10:00am on Monday 29 July 2019** to hear from as many people as possible.

If you wish to apply to speak at the public meeting, you must complete an expression of interest form and return it via email to ipcn@ipcn.nsw.gov.au so that it is received by no later than **5 pm on Wednesday 24 July 2019**.

And if you can't make it or just don't like public speaking, that's not a problem! You can make a written comment up to one week after the meeting. Written comments are weighed the same as spoken presentations.

This public meeting will be recorded, and a written transcript published on our website.
