• The expansion of the Eraring ash dump

- No public meeting regarding the ash dump expansion enabling transparency to the process The addition of 5,000,000 cubic meters of coal ash to the existing ash dump is unacceptable because
- Uncontrolled wind blown dust..most noticeable on 12 Nov 2019, blowing onto residential communities of Wangi Wangi and Dora Creek
- Heavy metal pollution from both leachate and surface storm water into Lake Macquarie, where levels of selenium and cadnium are off the chart
- The failure of Eraring Power Station to re-use 80% of the ash produced.
- It only gets the ash dump's capacity to 2026, with a lot more coal ash to come to the 2032 closure date.
- Adding more coal ash to an existing unlined ash dump with uncontrolled leachate flow into Lake Macquarie.
- Adding more coal ash increases the likelihood of wall failure in a seismic event.
