Glendell Mine MOD 4 (DA 80/952)

In its consideration of the abovementioned application, the Independent Planning Commission (the **Commission**) has identified a number of matters which would be assisted by further clarification. These matters were outlined in general terms during the Commission's meeting with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (the **Department**) on Thursday 23 January 2020.

The Commission seeks clarification from the Department on the following:

- 1) The number of dwellings in Camberwell that are not under mining ownership;
- 2) Provision of a table of Camberwell properties with/without acquisition rights (including under which consent and whether the consent is operational):
- 3) With respect to the draft recommended instrument (<u>Glendell Mod 4 Instrument of Modification Draft Revised to IPC Jan 2020</u>), clarification of the intent and effect of the following:
 - a) The request of the Resource Regulator to include "/or" in Schedule 2, Condition 5 specifically in relation to that amendment potentially allowing the Resource Regulator to be satisfied as to the provision of offsets;
 - b) The replacement of "Note:" with "a" in Schedule 2, Condition 14 specifically as to how the "a" will relate to (b) of that condition;
 - c) The need for notes a and b in Schedule 3, Condition 37C;
 - d) Whether Schedule 3 Condition 38 needs to be retained or amended in light of the Note at the end of the Condition:
 - e) Whether the conditions effectively operate to require a revision of the existing Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Management Plan (under Schedule 3 Condition 44 of the Consolidated Consent) to accommodate Mod 4. If this is not the case, the Panel proposes an addition to Condition 44 similar to the following: "(b1) be updated and resubmitted to the Secretary for approval prior to

any disturbance of land approved by Modification 4"; and

f) The proposal to remove Schedule 3 Condition 51 and replace it with a new Condition 23A in the same Schedule when Condition 51 appears to have a more comprehensive set of requirements related to reducing greenhouse gas emissions from the site.



The Commission would be grateful if the Department could provide a response to these matters by the close of business on **Monday 3 February 2020**.
