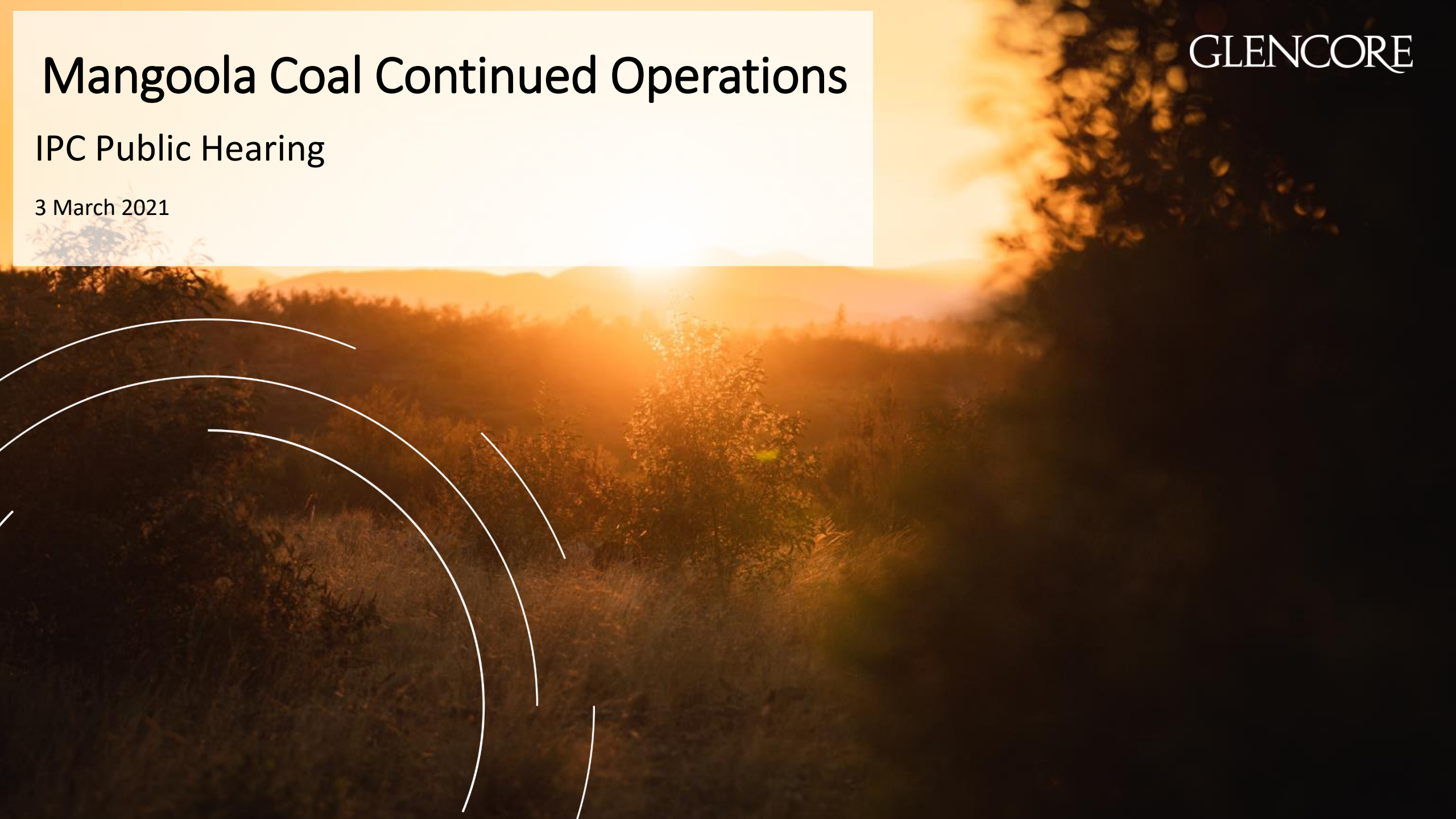

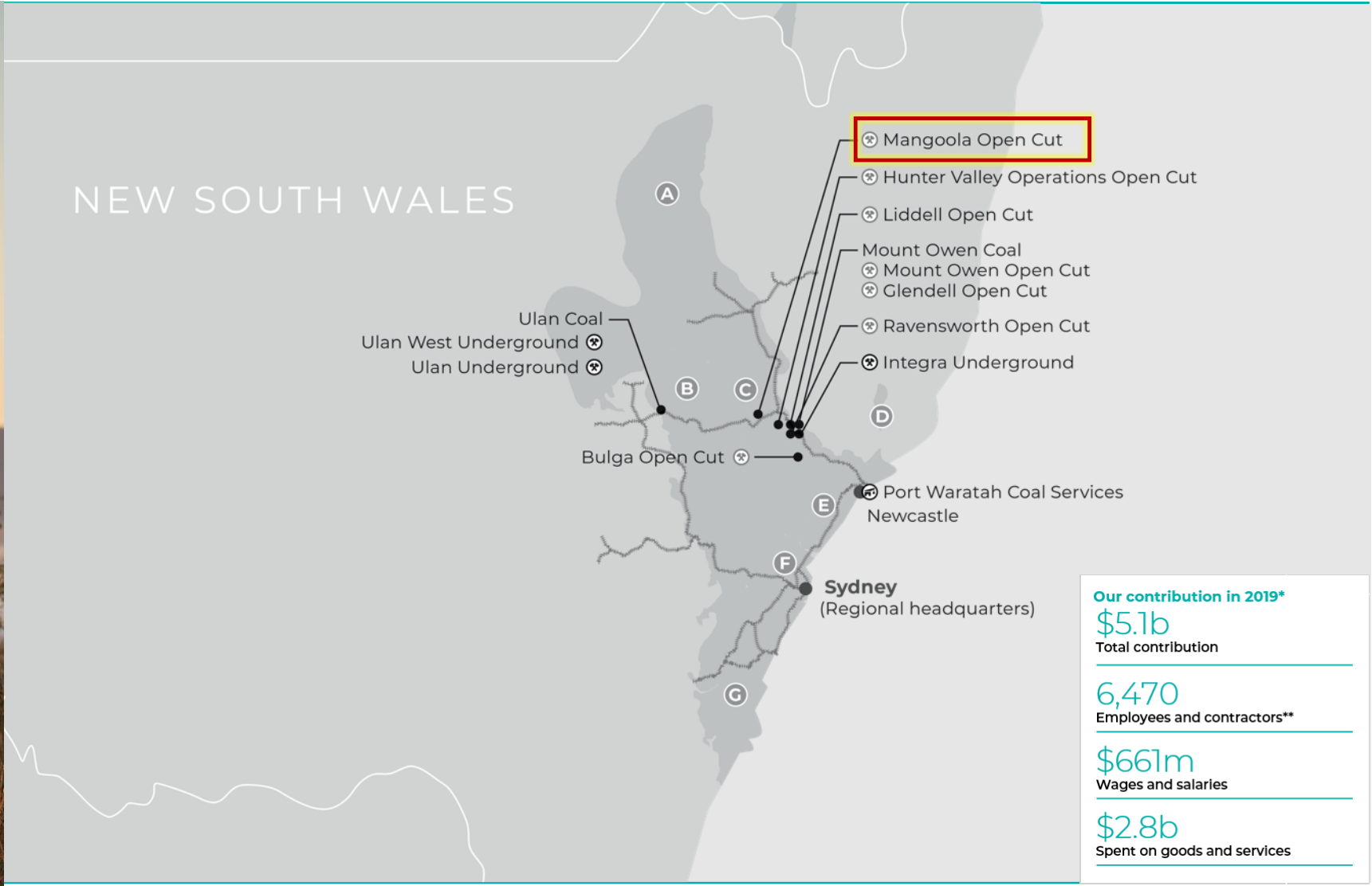

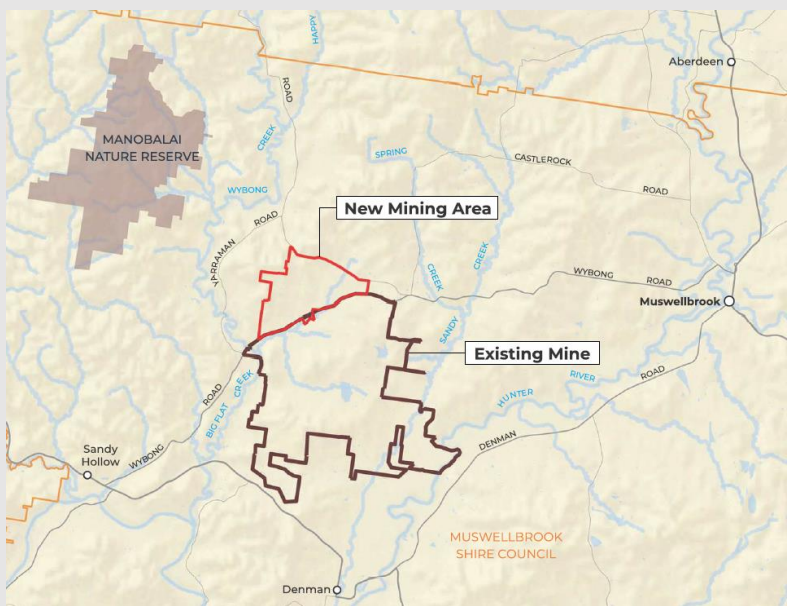
# Glencore Coal operations in New South Wales

## Mangoola Open Cut Operations

Commenced 2010  
13.5 Mtpa extraction limit  
High Quality Infrastructure  
Approved until November 2029



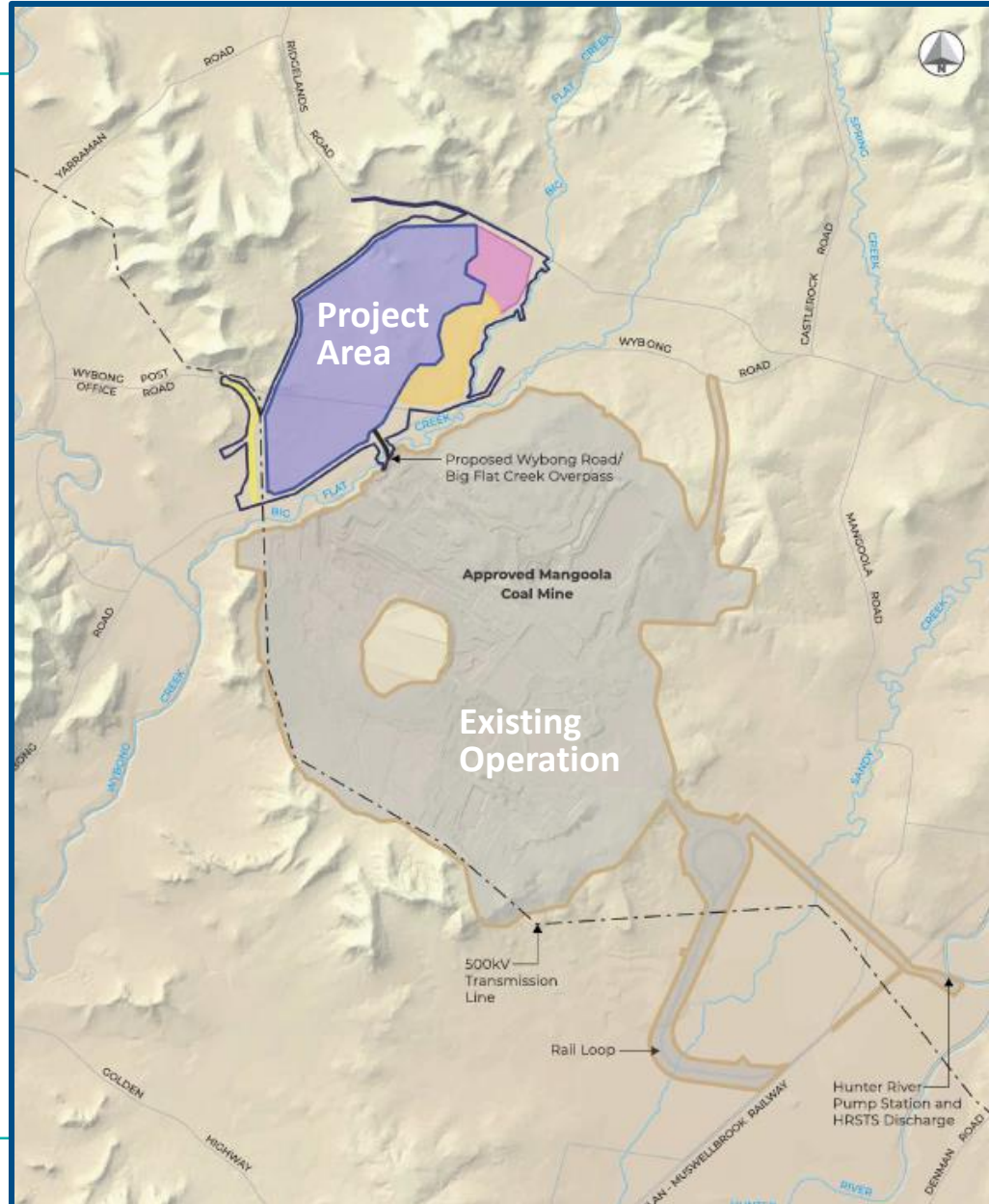
**88% employees live locally.**



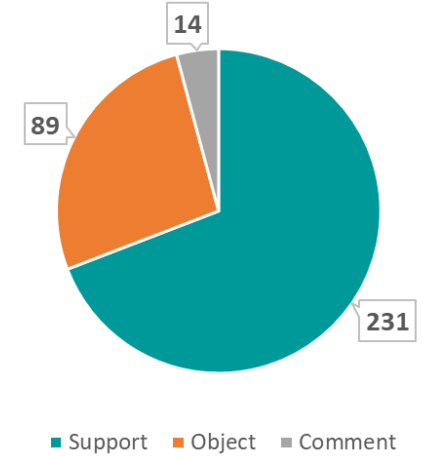
**State of the art infrastructure**

- Brownfield extension
- Extends life of mine to 2030
- 52Mt additional coal
- Continued employment opportunities for 400 workers
- Plus around 145 during construction
- Approximately \$52M capital investment

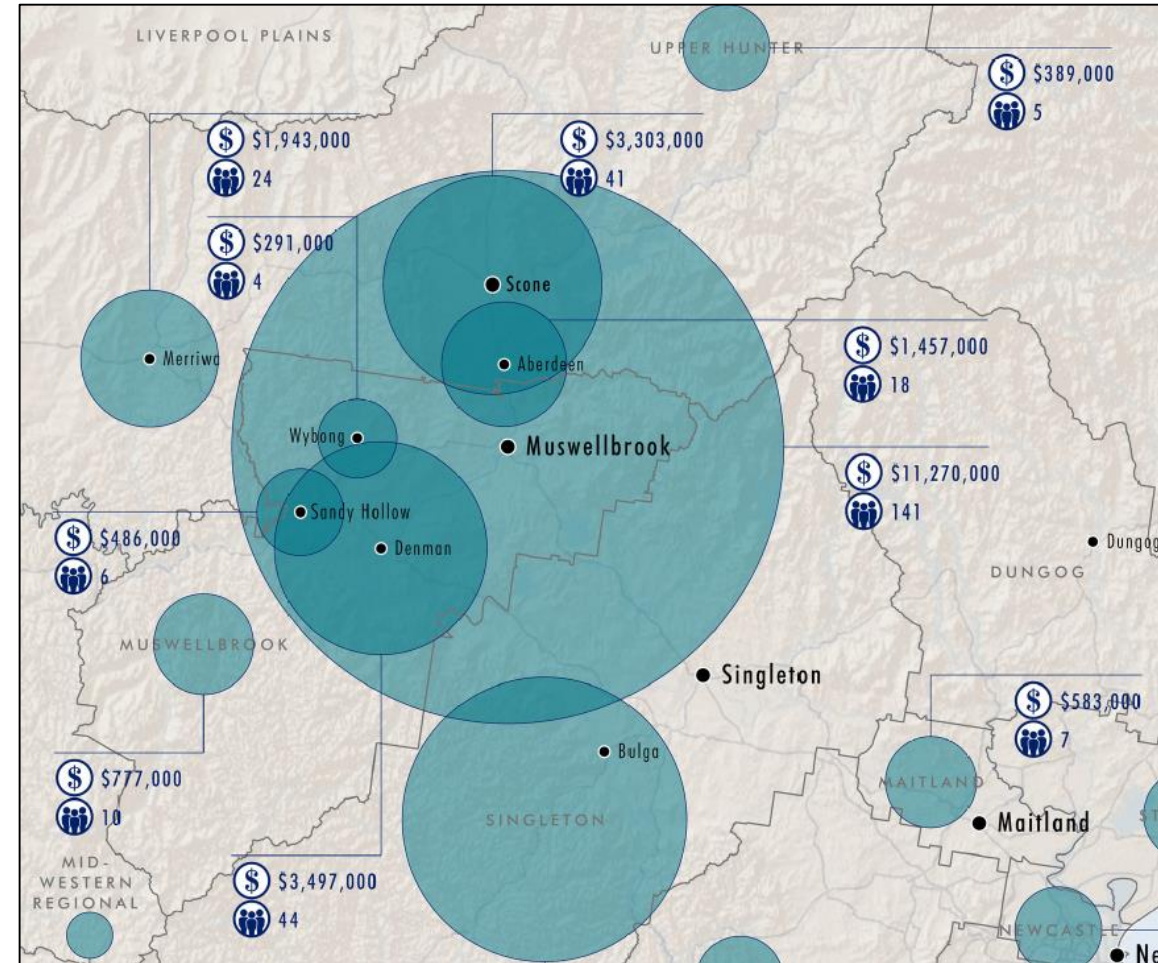
**Detailed Environmental Impact Assessment has been undertaken**



Mangoola Project Submissions



- Workforce approximately 400 people
  - Muswellbrook (51%)
  - Upper Hunter (22%)
  - Singleton (14%)
- Mangoola employees spend \$32M annually locally
- \$102M was spent on suppliers during 2018
- Net benefit to NSW of \$409M NPV
- \$95.6M net benefit in the Upper Hunter
- Muswellbrook Council VPA
  - \$10.7M spent to date
  - Approx \$800k spent annually on roads and community initiatives

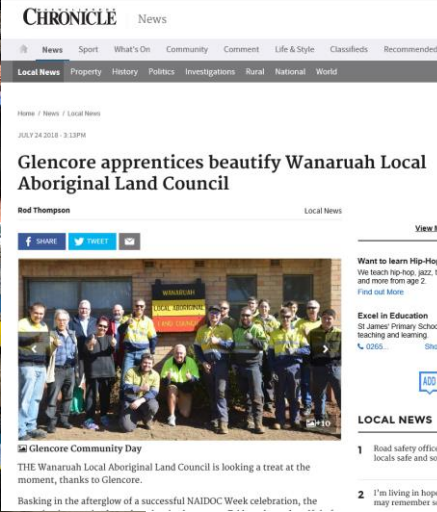

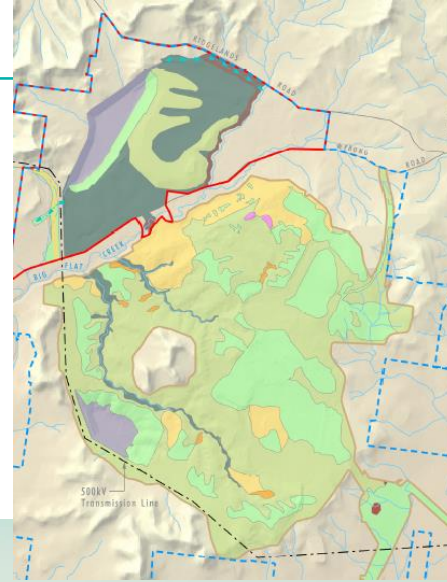

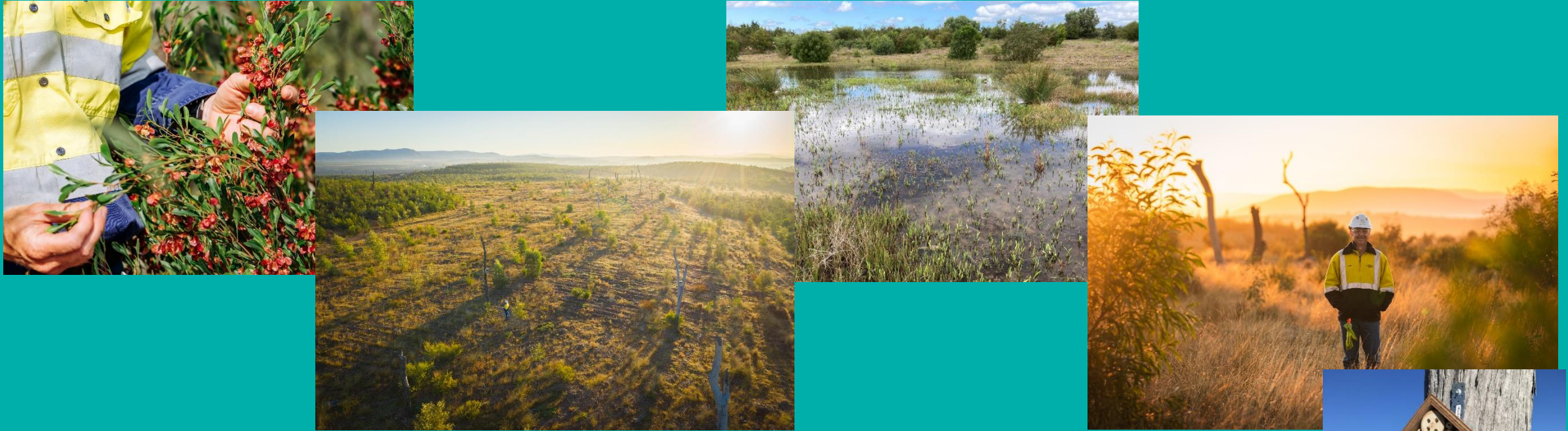


- Industry leading progressive rehabilitation

  - Over 70 woodland birds species recorded

  - Secondary succession observed
