This would also happen on the walkway into the many hotels in Pymont in front of ODH & Ibis, as I have observed that most of the visitors to this area stop & take photos of the city & Cockle Bay & having a beautiful park area at the foreground of their photo would certainly be much better than a wall or roof.

If this section is allowed to be of such a height as Mirvac want, it will not invite the public to visit & explore this area as was encouraged in 1988, so that all the foreshores in the harbour should be able to be enjoyed by all, not a handful that work on the inside & are able to enjoy it.
