Thank you for your letter on 4 November 2021 providing notification of exhibition of the Heliport Developers Pty Ltd development application (DA21/15298).

The Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications is responsible for delivering the airspace and flight path design for single runway operations at the Western Sydney International Airport (WSI).

The Department continues to work on the preliminary airspace design which will be subject to environmental assessment, including community feedback, in due course. However the helipad proposal located in Castlereagh is outside of the controlled airspace volume currently proposed for the WSI, and is unlikely to present a conflict with this airspace. You should note that the WSI airspace concept is not complete and will be subject to further design work until the commencement of operations in late 2026.
