Once again we are writing to you
to voice your concerns over another
Quarry Expansion.

Hanson Quarry has been approved
to increase , double its output,
now its Razacow at Marler's Creek.

Hanson has been given
approval to go from 700,000 thousand
tons per year to 1,500 million. This
in its self will be an insurmountable
amount of truck movements.

How can another Quarry of this
size be allowed to operate in
over what was once a quiet
Rural Lifestyle neighbourhood.

This would be a disaster for the
Town of Paterson & adjoining areas
such as Belwana, East Hartland.
Residents of Brandy Hill who
already have to cope with
Hanson & sub-contract trucks.

Marler's Creek Quarry in past
years was mainly for Rail
Balls & was delivered by Rail.

If Razacow should operate this
Quarry my thinking would be that
Road delivery would be preferred.

Hanson trucks plus any subcontractors now operate between 6am-1pm with a sub clause written into allow extended hours of operation should the need arise.

If another Quarry should be allowed to operate in addition to Hanson Quarry we would be in a total unacceptable situation with the amount of truck movements.

We value our lifestyle, semi-rural surrounding & an addition of another Quarry to our area would completely ruin & make totally unsafe for our well being.

Another potential hazard would be trucks from Paterson Quarry crossing over Northern Rail Line at Paterson which is only a level crossing.

None of these small country towns & roads were designed to take B-Double, Truck Dog & Tyre Gravel Trucks. an example is Butterwick Road, a dangerous intersection.

This will become a major safety risk to all ordinary members & not to mention School children.

Stand at an inappropriate positioned Bus Stop I make from passing gravel trucks.

Please carefully consider this expansion as this is not a safe situation.
