We are Jim & Sue Robinson, next door property owners of Lot 47/DP753722, Receiver DAD 1 and have been neighbours to this property for the past 35 years and over the past 28 years, the property has been neglected.

A large portion of this property is overrun with blackberry's and in the spring and summer it has areas of nodding thistles.

Being the neighbouring property, this creates problems for us. Each year we spend alot of time and money to control the blackberry's and nodding thistles that have blown over the fence and carried into our property from wildlife.

And because no-one has lived at this property for around 5 years, the pigs and deers have bred up on this place and we are now left with the problem of trying to control the feral animals.

Most of the fences on this property are non-exisitng or falling down except for the fence line on our boundary.

The benefits from the wind farm providing power for the future for around 700,000 people outweighs a property that is run down, no one living there and the owner lives in Canberra.

So we support this land aquisition.

It is currently leased by anti wind farm members trying to stop the wind farm. Right now they are running 5 cows and around 20 goats which keep getting thru our fence onto our property.

If this land aquisition of Lot 47/DP753722 gets approved, we hope the next owner would maintain the property.
