I wish to continue my objection to the proposed destruction of amenity and environment by building an industrial wind park on the mountains surrounding Nundle NSW.

This proposal is entirely out of character for the purpose of land use and against the wishes of the majority of the community in which it is proposed to be built. It is to be built outside of a designated renewable energy zone meaning that they can be built wherever a developer chooses.

The development is borderline in profitability without adding back the turbines removed because they didn't comply to recommendations and closeness to an approved development application to build a dwelling on adjoining private land.

The suggestion that Engie acquire that property by 'voluntary acquisition' and/or seek to have the positioning of the dwelling altered to enable the removed turbines to be built, sucks.
