

This feels like déjà vu! Will this be the last time that the community will be called to make submissions on a revised application from the proponent? I have spoken to numerous members of the Nundle and Hanging Rock community about making a comment to this latest project revision, the feedback has been clear "The department and/or IPC have not previously taken into consideration our previous community submissions, therefore we will not be wasting our time on another submission".

This project has broken our community. I sincerely believe, intentionally or unintentionally, the proponent has dragged this project on for as long as it has to break the resolve of the community. Enough is enough!

There is something fundamentally wrong with this project and with the assessment of wind farm projects generally. I understand that wind farm projects (proposed, in assessment, approved, in development, in work) in NSW far exceed the future requirements. Therefore, this is a wonderful opportunity for the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure to assess all project together and choose the projects that will give the best return for the environment, nearby communities and overall public benefit. It is clear that this project, with the long delays and numerous revisions, has little public benefit. Please reject this project so that other better suited projects can be approved and built.
