## Mayfield Cargo Storage Facility Modification 2 - DA-8137 Mod 2 Questions on Notice and Request for Clarification

I refer to the modification application for the Mayfield Cargo Storage Facility (DA-8137 Mod 2) (**Modification 2**), currently before the Independent Planning Commission (**Commission**) for determination.

The Commission is seeking information from the Port of Newcastle (**Applicant**) on the following matters:

- Please provide further explanation of the rationale for amending the noise quotas for the expanded cargo storage area (refer page 32 of Applicant's Statement of environmental effects)?
- 2. Noting that remediation of the site was required under DA 293-08-00 and Voluntary Remediation Agreement 26025 (the latter of which has now been executed), does the remediation of the former Koppers Operational Area require a separate approval under the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979*, including a new site remediation and verification process?
- 3. Given it is in the public interest for the former Koppers Operational Area to be remediated, what is the expected timeframe for remediation?

The Commission requests that the Applicant provide a response by **5pm on Monday 29 January 2024.**
