*I strongly OBJECT to the proposed Thunderbolt Wind Farm for the following reasons;*

*- There has been little to no consultation with community around the proposed development. This has caused mass division amongst community members; seemingly uniformed, biased hosts; so many questions unanswered. It is despicable that a development such as this can be discussed and decided on behind closed doors and pushed ahead by those who are driven by profit.*

*- Concerns around noise and light pollution and the consequential impacts on people and animals in the area. Identified poor health outcomes with wind turbine development- decreased quality of life, stress, sleep disturbance, headache, anxiety, depression, nausea and cognitive dysfunction. I hold grave concerns for the health and wellbeing of my young family.*

*- Bushfire risk and inability to access aerial support*

*- Loss of biodiversity and wildlife habitat. There are several identified critically endangered species in the area such as the swift parrot and regent honeyeater and box gum grassy woodland.*

*- Loss of koala habitat*

*- Loss of Bell's Turtles habitat*

*- Relatively short operational life of wind turbines- what happens to them when they fail to function?*

*- An inordinate amount of material and resources are required to build a single turbine*
