Our key take away form the meeting is that main issue you have is the potential unknowns that you have about a new quarry and a new operator. While Boral Quarry is also nearby, Eagleton is closer, so there are some unknowns for how it might actually affect your business and most importantly its residents and the staff. We know Eagleton Ridge is home to permanent residents and is intended to operate long into the future, providing a wide range of disability services to both its onsite residents, people in other homes and other people with disabilities. We fully understand and respect your position and appreciate the efforts you have put into the business and the valuable service it provides to the community and the people that call it home. We'd like to reiterate the commitment of Eagleton Rock to work with Eagleton Ridge to ensure the two businesses can work together and to help allay your concerns of the effects of the quarry. While these need some further discussion, some of the ideas that we discussed included: Eagleton Rock covering the costs for say the first 12 months of the quarry operation for Eagleton Ridge to take its residents on day trips on the days planned for blasting to alleviate potential startle reflex risks. For Eagleton Rock to cover the costs of double glazing the north / quarry facing windows of buildings if noise levels were higher than expected or suitable for its residents. That management plans are designed to monitor and measure impacts then adjust operations to minimise impacts. Undertake monitoring onsite as needed to ensure the predicted levels match actual. To ensure Eagleton Ridge always has a direct connection to both the Quarry Manager and quarry owners to ensure issues can be resolved Consider the background noise levels collected for Eagleton Ridge by Spectrum Acoustics compared to the data used in the modelling of the quarry impacts and let Eagleton Ridge know how it compares. If there is anything that I've missed or you think of any other issues, please let me know. I've CC'd Darren into the email and you can get in touch with him on Kind Regards Jonatha
