MECHANICAL VENTILATION

E39

 To ensure that the performance and functioning (including in relation to air flow and To ensure that the performance and functioning uncluding in relation to air now and quality, and rules acoustic compliance) of the proposed mechanical ventilation system is monitored on an ongoing basis (should the consent, for example, be sold on to another developer)

The mechanical ventilation system must be regularly monitored and maintained and in good working order at all times. This is to ensure it of with this development consent, its level of performance at time of missioning and as required by Condition B20.
