We are in regional NSW and employ 22 sawmill workers. They are local and wish to stay here.

They have mortgages and families to feed. They also support the local community. If the sawmills have to close this would effect not only the local retailers but the schools and hospitals.

There is also a follow on effect- we are only a small community but it reaches out national wide.

We support our suppliers from Freight, Fuel, Maintainence, Mechanics, Packaging etc.

Our sawmill has been the cornerstone of the local community since its establishment in 1947. For 77 years this family-run business has provided essential timber products and woven itself into the fabric of the regions history and development.

The area around Warrell Creek has long been used for agricultural purposes with sawmills playing a crucial role in servicing the timber industry. The Warrell Creek Sawmill has been a significant part of this history, providing timber for various uses, including pallet work, roof battens, fencing and structural timber.

The sawmill also supplies by-products, such as woodchips, sawdust and woodchip fines to other businesses in the Landscape, poultry and feedlot industries, creating a circular economy that maximizes the use of its resources.
