Topic 1. Sustainability of current and future forestry operations in NSW

We urge the Forestry Corporation to spare the Nambucca State Forest, extending to Hyland Park village, from further logging, and especially clear felling. This is a modest-sized parcel of land but it harbours an important variety of native fauna; wallabies, kangaroos, sugar gliders, possums, amongst others. It also provides safe haven for native bird species being driven out by marauding flocks of noisy minors, which, although also native, have become endemic in the increasingly cleared urban land surrounding the forest.
