I am a retired medical practitioner who is a resident in an aged care facility, and I object to the proposed development because of the perceived environmental pollution of residual microplastic substances in the local environment on this elderly population. The proposed site is unsuitable because of its small size and the lack of any buffer zones which could protect this community from pollutants.

The bushfire risk is considerable.

There are impacts with dust pollution from heavy trucks. Braddon Road is a residential street and so is vulnerable.

There is a high risk of increased respiratory disease from these chemicals, including cancers.

There is evidence of residual carcinogenic chemicals in the local water supply from these pollutants which are long lasting.
