My entire family resides in the Moss Vale area, and I'm deeply concerned for the myriad of potential social, safety and logistical impacts of this proposal.

Most concerningly, I've been made aware of the underestimated dangers of airborne microplastics, fumes and runoff for the local and wider community, that will occur as a result of this new development.

I'm conscious that as a result, the successful building of the refinery will cause many members of the community to leave, disrupting and draining the wonderful community spirit of the town.

Aside from this, any small disruptions to the traffic flow are felt tenfold in such a small community - I fear the town itself would not survive such a blow.

I'm writing to implore you to stop all propose developments, and find a new location for this plastics refinery. Although I see the innate value of the recycling plant, insufficient studies on the long term social, physical and economic wellbeing of the community have been undertaken, and further consideration on the correct and just location of the refinery is required.
