This is the wrong location for this type of industry. Moss Vale is a diverse community with dense residential area, schools, and surrounding farms. It has historical significance being one of the early settlements and has natural beauty and a thriving tourism trade. The roads are inadequate for the amount of heavy vehicles that this facility intends to operate. Visually the facility would be an eyesore in the landscape. The environmental impact would be significant, negatively affecting surrounding farms and wildlife populations, the main and immediate concern being the extent of negative health impact to humans and animals. The micro particles released through processing would be inhaled by all in the surrounding extended Southern Highlands via the high winds which are part of seasonal weather conditions. Also, the toxic micro particle refuse released into our waterways and drinking water reservoir will adversely impact the health of humans, farm animals and wildlife, with risk of cancer and other negative health impacts. Additionally, our water supply subsequently feeds into Sydney's water catchment exposing all Sydney residents to health risks from these polluting carcinogens. If this industry is allowed to go ahead it will negatively impact the local Southern Highlands tourism industry and therefore the livelihood of the many locals who operate cafes, restaurants, BnB, golf courses, tours, retailers, etc. Many residents, myself and my family included, will feel compelled to relocate due to the health risks sited above.
