My objections to this proposal are as follows:-

- 1.State decisions approving massive new housing developments in Wingecarribee Shire are not supported by the majority of the local community, and are converting a unique rural environment to a suburb of metro-Sydney. Much of the new housing is not suited to the needs of young working families and is not supported by necessary investments in infrastructure- new and improve roads, more parking, additional rail services, hospital places, schools etc. Building this facility will further degrade the rural environment and trucking material to and from this facility will put even more pressure on the infrastructure and the quality of life.
- 2. There is virtually full employment in the Shire. Creating 140 new jobs only is no argument for building this facility.
- 3. Plastics processing may release carcinogenic chemicals into the environment and will certainly release microplastics. A facility like this should not be located In a populated area because of the possibility of leaks either as a result of normal processing or of fires or other accidents,
