My husband and I moved to the Highlands 12 years ago and value the community and its natural environment greatly. We are fully committed to a wholistic and thoughtful approach to recycling waste plastic. However, we do not and will never support a plastics recycling company being located in a populated and environmentally sensitive area (Wingecaribee water catchment for Sydney).

Our other significant objections include:
