As a rate paying resident of Moss Vale for the past 25 years, I strongly oppose the proposed plastic recycling development.

The content of a report aired on channel 9's A Current Affair on Thursday, 14 November 2024 was very concerning. I was absolutely astonished to hear that the Air Quality Report stated $\hat{a} \in \text{People living near the site}$ would be able to manage their exposure to air quality impacts, through minimising time spent outdoors'. The fact that this statement was made in writing suggests the company (Plasrefine Recycling) has absolutely no regard for Environmental, Health and Safety. If it was suggested we minimise our time spent outdoors, then we could assume the air pollutants emitted into the atmosphere will adversely affect our health and the environment. The proposal should be rejected on these grounds alone.

I was also surprised to learn that Plasrefine Recycling is a new company with no history in recycling. This raises concerns about its ability to safely manage the company with virtually no experience or expertise in the industry.
