Another particular concern, and one I am surprised has not prevented the application in the first place is its proximity to creeks/rivers that feed into Sydney Water drinking supply. We are all too familiar with the impact microplastics already has on the health of humans, but also the impact it would have on our aquatic animals like the platypus that reside in these rivers, is likely to be drastic. The road maintenance will be too hard to maintain, dust will impact residents and increased danger on these roads is unacceptable. A facility like this needs to be a further distance from those mentioned above. I hope, with all my heart that this facility is not built here. I am all too familiar with the NIMBY phrase, and this is not a Not in My Back Yard situation, it is just not the right site.
