While I recognise the need for plastic recycling within Australia, this facility should be located within a heavy industrial area and well away from the activities that surround it at this site. I have been involved in factory location decision making throughout my career, having been CEO of CSR. I also served on the Board of the NSW EPA and for a time on the Board of the Garvan.

By their very nature recycling facilities experience a whole host of adventitious materials arriving onto the site that can give rise to contamination and discharge off site. A number of CSR's operations were involved in recycling so I have first hand experience of this. The EPA was involved in regulating these industries and they had a disproportionate share of the problems amongst licensed premises. I saw at first hand the range of problems that can arise because of the uncontrolled feeds that can find their way onto site

I have read the submissions including from the EPA and believe that the potential risks from this site to its neighbours need much greater consideration. The best solution is to locate the facility in a better place with other heavy industry

The proponents for this project have no experience in the industry and no experience operating a factory like this in Australia. This adds greatly to the potential for a catastrophe from this operation
