My objection to this proposal is based on the following:

GENERAL LOCATION

The vast majority of material to be processed will originate in Sydney, meaning it will need to be trucked a considerable distance for processing. The processed material will then need to be trucked back towards Sydney (Apin) and then on towards Wollongong for shipment overseas. This defies logic and will result in unnecessary truck movements (distance) with the accompanying pollution and road congestion.

SPECIFIC LOCATION

Site is simply too close to existing residential areas - applicant should be directed to find an alternative site with a greater buffer between it and existing residential areas.

POLLUTION

Again site is too close to existing residential areas - offering inadequate 'buffer' between the proposed facility and residential areas as regards any airborne pollutants. Site is also in a water catchment area and whilst acknowledging alleged mitigation proposals there is no guarantee that mitigation measures will be followed. A site outside a major water catchment area would be a simple way to negate this risk,

TRAFFIC

Local roads are totally inadequate for existing traffic, let alone a substantial increase in heavy traffic anticipated by this development. Additionally, the proposed traffic route may not necessarily be followed by truck drivers - particularly given that a shorter (albeit busier route during the day) exists via Mittagong / Bowral and Moss Vale town centre.
