As a constituent of the Southern Highlands I am writing to oppose the development of the Plasrefine Recycling Facility in Moss Vale.

I join with thousands of others to support the fact that this is an inappropriate site. As well documented in the media, online & at public meetings the environmental implementations will be damaging & profound not only in the Southern Highlands but to those cities, Sydney & Wollongong, whose water is sourced from Warragamba Dam where produced contaminants would flow.

Due to it's proposed proximity to residential homes & a nearby child care facility there will undoubtedly be health implications. Industrial noise, which will no doubt emanate from the site, will be exacerbated by the continual noise of heavy trucks coming into & out of the site.

A great concern to me is reportedly the 2 individuals driving this

have had no previous experience in implementing an industry of this nature. In effect this would be an experiment unleashed on a community who simply want to live healthily & peacefully in a rural setting.

While it has been acknowledged by the community that refining of plastics is necessary a site which has less environmental & social implications, implemented by experienced practitioners, would be preferential.
