My children go to school nearby and are outside for many hours a day both at school and at home. We have asthma and are very concerned about the release of microplastic fibres into the air in a very windy region, which will adversely affect our health and the health of the entire community, both directly through aggravating our breathing and lung health, as well as the many ways we know that micro plastics are being stored inside the body and contributing to a wide range of health concerns. Furthermore, the area is a committed regenerative farming area and the building of the plant at this proposed site will have a devastating affect on the soil quality, water (including our drinking water), and crop / food quality. As a family we are committed to buying locally grown food as much as possible, especially organic produce, and have taken pains to reduce toxins in our homes and in the water and products we use and consume. This plant is too close to families, homes, schools and food sources to be recognised as safe in any legitimate way, and takes away our right of choice to manage our own health. A foreign company with no track record of carefully managing the health consequences and environmental impact should never be allowed to proceed when there is overwhelming evidence concluding that the risks to children, families, animals and the environment are so great.
